John volunteered to bring in something for show and tell. More Show and Tell is needed for this meeting.

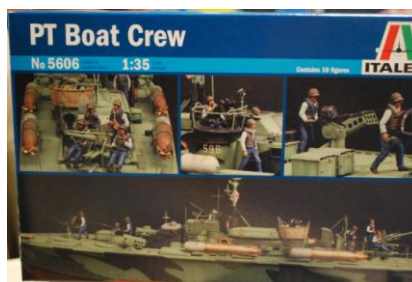
## SHIPS NEWS

John brought in to show us a PT Boat Crew figures from Italeri that are 1:35 scale that he bought at Gold Coast Hobby.



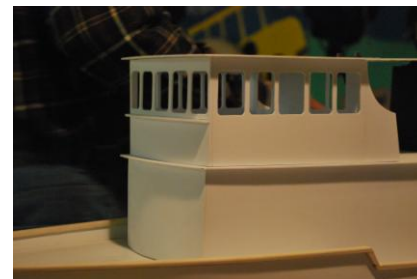
